N°	Question	Answer
Q1	Is there the possibility of modifying or including any clause in the final contract in order to contemplate the terms and conditions of the awarded company – including, but not limited to, limitation of liability?	In principle it is not possible to modify the draft contract, except in the case of very specific and justified circumstances subject to the agreement or not by UIC.
Q2	Would it be possible to get a two-week extension to the deadline for the tender submission? It would help us to make a better offer.	We believe that one month from publication is sufficient time for a proposal of this type. Please take in mind that this is a modest project that does not require significant resources. Section 6 provides guidance on the team required for this work. As a guideline, we do not believe that the technical proposal should exceed 15-20 pages, although we will not penalise longer proposals.
